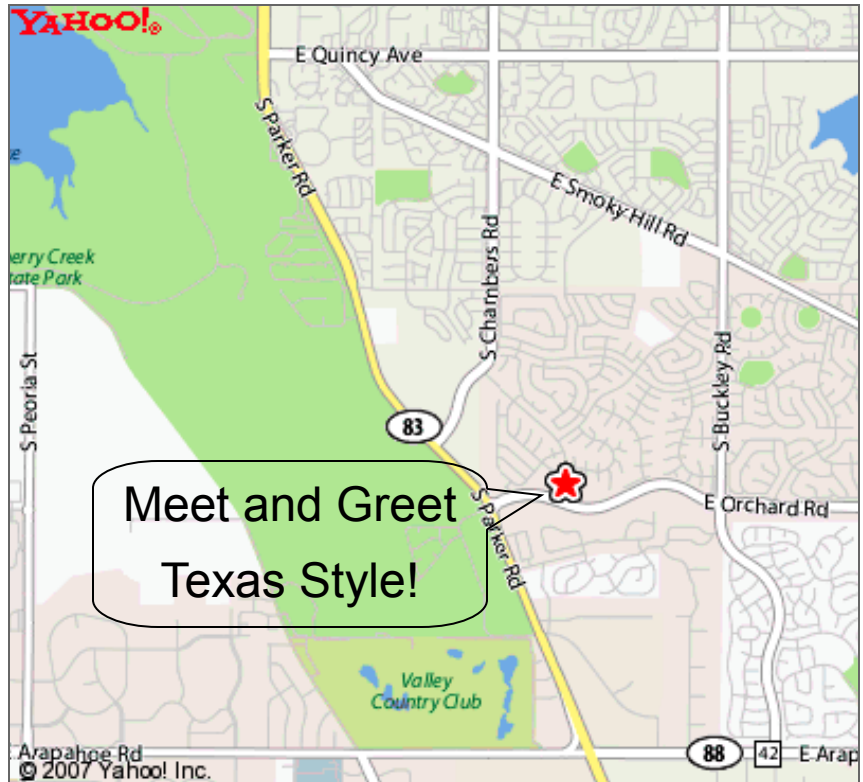

In his workshop, “**Background Check Boot Camp for Churches**”, Steve will address these questions,

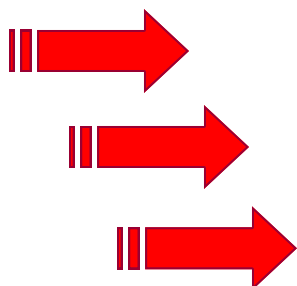
among others: “Is your ministry as safe as it could be?” Is your screening process thorough enough?”
